

SNR Energy Imbalance Market Efforts

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BANC Exploration of CAISO's Western EIM

- BANC members began exploring the EIM in 2016 after termination of the Pacific Northwest market development effort.
- BANC determined to use a “phased approach” for its members to evaluate EIM.
 - As part of Phase I, SMUD announced its decision to pursue membership in EIM in March 2017 and became a member in spring 2019.
 - In Phase II, several other BANC members are exploring whether to become EIM participants.

SNR Exploration of EIM

- Phase II provides an opportunity for SNR and Reclamation to explore EIM participation that may increase the value of the CVP, improve operational flexibility and optimize generation scheduling and market value
- One of the CVP Power Initiatives
- Exploring membership in the EIM will allow SN to keep pace with industry changes and determine how the EIM will affect SN's ability to accomplish its mission in more effective and beneficial way for its customers.

What SNR Is Doing

- Performing a gap analysis under BANC's Phase II EIM initiative
- Coordinating with BPA on policy and governance issues
- Holding customer meetings and webinars to share information with customers and receive feedback and input into the analysis

SNR EIM Decision

SNR is committed to:

- Being transparent with customers about the gap analysis and decision on whether to join the EIM
- Sharing information to alleviate customers' key concerns about joining EIM
- SNR will make a decision about joining EIM no later than August 16, 2019
